Sorting and Inspection of Garments Before Washing: to remove any foreign objects.

Chip/Barcode Scanning (Incoming Traceability):

Garments are sorted by type and level of dirt.

Restoration using processes, temperature, and chemical ingredients tailored to the chosen fabric, type of dirt, and the specific technical requirements of the PPE.



Laundering

Industrial ironing with tunnel finishing;

Quality control with possible mending;

Uniforms sorting by client/operator;

Chip scanning (outgoing traceability), quantity control;

Packaging of uniforms in heat-sealed polyethylene bags.
