THE BRCGS PLANT-BASED GLOBAL STANDARD CAN BE USED BY FOOD MANUFACTURERS PRODUCING VEGETARIAN AND VEGAN PRODUCTS.

It applies only to the control of animal inputs in plant-based products, in the manufacture, processing and packing of:

- Processed foods, both own brand and customer branded.
- Ingredients for use by food service companies, catering companies, and food manufacturers.
- Pet foods (GFSI benchmarked schemes only).
- Natural health products.

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STEPS TO CERTIFICATION



GETTING STARTED Read the Standard and Interpretation Guideline publications thoroughly to familiarise yourself with the Standard and its requirements.



LEARN

Attend training with the BRCGS Academy to gain a practical understanding of implementing the requirements.



SUBMIT LICENCE AGREEMENT AND SCHEDULE A Complete a License Agreement and the Schedule A document (both available on the BRCGS website) and submit these to BRCGS. This provides a list of recognised products eligible to display the plant-based trademark after certification has been granted. This must be approved by BRCGS prior to any third-party audit.



REVIEW

Perform a self-assessment gap analysis with the Standard (gap-analysis tool available on the BRCGS website). Assemble and train a team for implementation. Obtain consultancy if needed.



PREPARE Use the outputs of the self-assessment to develop an action plan to implement the Standard requirements in your operation. Carry out risk assessments where needed and establish necessary control points. Prepare your procedures and undertake internal audits.



PLAN AUDIT

BRCGS certification audits are delivered by our network of approved certification bodies. Contact your chosen or existing certification body to arrange an audit. Make sure you plan ahead so that staff are available and preparations are made.



ON-SITE AUDIT The audit will assess the practical implementation of the Standard requirements. Observation of procedures and processes, review of documentation, and staff interviews will all take place.



NON-CONFORMITIES AND CORRECTIVE ACTION If non-conformities are identified, you will need to carry out any corrective action, root cause analysis and plan preventive action. These will be closed out within 28 days following the audit.



CERTIFICATION Your certification body will review the non-conformities and finalise the audit report to determine whether certification be awarded. If certification is achieved, the certification body will issue your certificate within 42 calendar days from the first day of your audit.

TRAINING FOR SITES PREPARING FOR PLANT-BASED CERTIFICATION

- Have a practical knowledge of how to interpret the Standard requirements and how to implement a preventative, risk-based plant-based management system.
- Be familiar with BRCGS audit methodology, the preparation required and post-audit activities.
